BOND	<p>Payable to secure a booking and is calculated at \$40 per day of booking, minimum payment of \$300. Bond refunded if all is in order after a camp inspection and will be deducted from invoice. <b>NOTE:</b> Hirers must ensure the clean-up is complete and the camp is ready for the next group to use, otherwise cleaning charges will apply.</p>
FEES	<p>Camper Rate: \$14.00 per person per night. Day Visitor Rate: \$6.00 per person per day. Minimum Charge: \$280.00 per night/day. Family Group Rates: Contact the Booking Officer No charge for children under five years old. Fees will be invoiced and payment is due by due date shown on the invoice. Preferred payment method is by direct credit. Cheques payable to “<b>Community of Christ Karanga Camp</b>” and mailed to Booking Officer. <b>Prices may change without notice.</b></p>
ARRIVAL TIME	<p><b>4:00pm</b> – Early arrival is by arrangement only and a fee will be charged. Minimum Charge or Day Visitor Rate will apply.</p>
DEPARTURE TIME	<p><b>2:30pm</b> – Late departure is by arrangement only and a fee will be charged. Minimum Charge or Day Visitor Rate will apply.</p>
ACCOMODATION	<p>4 cabin buildings with 2 rooms each. 7 rooms sleep 7 people, and 1 room sleeps 5 people (total of 54 people). 3 bedrooms in the hall sleep 6 people per room (18 people). Maximum capacity is 72 people. Bunk beds with foam mattresses, heaters in cabin buildings.</p>
KITCHEN	<p>Equipped for self-catering with a six element commercial stove with fan oven, toaster, refrigerator, freezer, stainless steel benches, steriliser, storeroom, continuous hot water, cooking utensils, crockery and cutlery. BBQ on site (gas supplied).</p>
DINING ROOM	<p>Tables and chairs.</p>
ABLUTIONS	<p>Hot showers and flushing septic toilets.</p>
WATER	<p>Filtered tank water.</p>



## RECREATION

- At camp you can
    - Play on the two playing fields
    - Walk the bush tracks
    - Use the hall for all-weather activities
    - Do problem solving activities
    - Orienteering
    - Do native flora/fauna studies
    - Campfire pit – fire restrictions are in place between November and March, during this time a fire permit is required to have a campfire. This can be arranged at no cost. Please contact the Booking Officer if you want to apply for a permit.
  - Travel short distance to
    - Cascade Kauri Park - many different bush walks and water holes for young swimmers ( 5 minutes by car)
    - Bethells Beach (15 minutes by car)
    - Lake Wainamu and sand dunes walk (15 minutes by car plus 20 minute walk) This fresh water lake, although deep is great swimming in summer.
    - Crystal Mountain – cafe, theme park and museum.

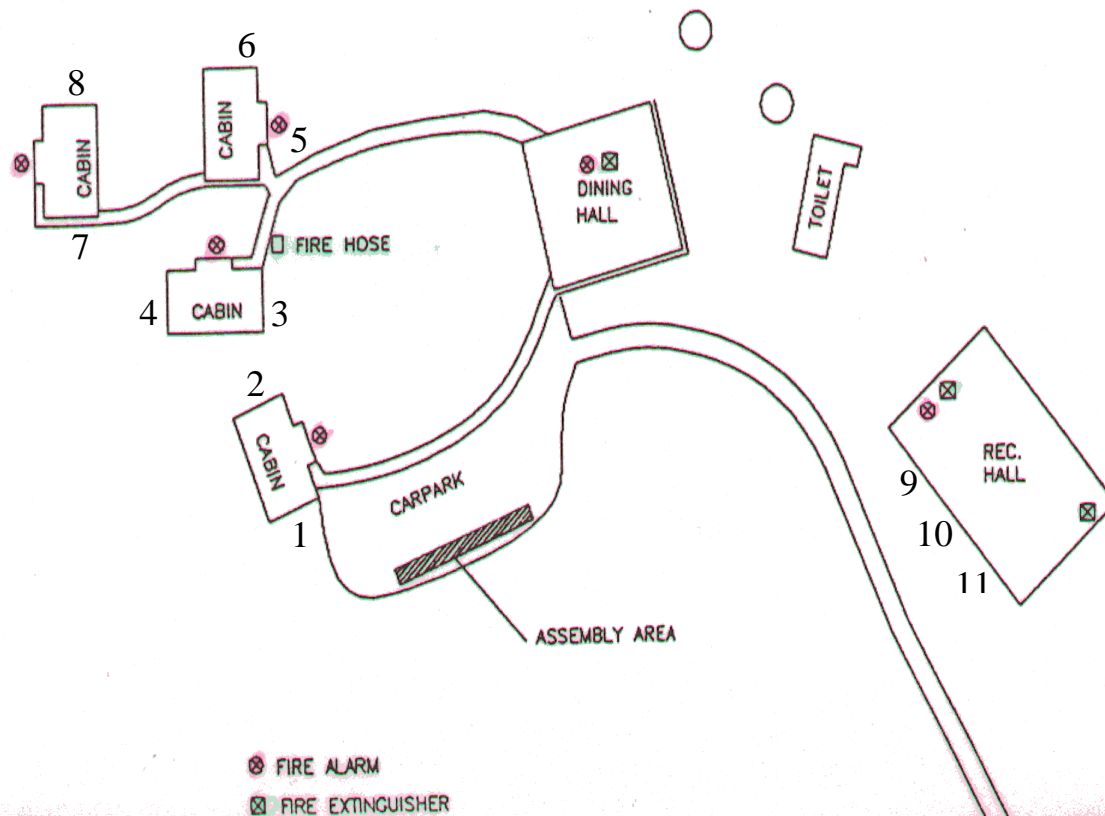

### How to find us:

- From Auckland highway 16 (northwest motorway) take Lincoln Road off-ramp.
- At the traffic lights at the corner of Universal Dr and Lincoln Road turn right into Universal Dr.
- Continue until you get to the roundabout. Go 'straight' through...you will now be on Swanson Rd.
- Continue until you have passed through Ranui village, and then passed through Swanson village.
- Continue climbing up into the Waitakere ranges. When you go under the Rail Bridge continue for approx 2.7km along Scenic Drive.
- Turn right into Te Henga Rd.
- Continue approx 1.8km until you come to the clearly marked Karanga Camp sign at 79 Te Henga Rd.

If you miss the entrance you will pass the Te Henga Rd Quarry further down the hill.

NB - do not go up Falls Rd on the left !!

NB – Driveways to no. 75 and no. 77 look similar. Look for the sign
